From the beginning of December 2008 we are sourcing Poterion from Stellar Fairtrade Organic Winery in the Western Cape of South Africa following the unfortunate closure of Los Robles Fairtrade Winery in Chile who have ceased trading due to financial problems. We have managed to reproduce wine that tastes and looks exactly the same as our original

Fairtrade Communion Wine.

The wine itself comes in a screw top 75cl bottle and has good longevity. It is lightly fortified to 15% alcohol content. It is light red in colour with berry fruit flavours and a balancing sweetness that has been well-received by communicants throughout the UK.
