We are a small Justice and Peace Group who meet once a month every second Sunday of the month. We raise funds for various causes and groups and live out the Justice and Peace message.

Every Christmas we raise funds for the **Coventry Open Christmas Night Shelter** for the homeless and lonely which operates from the Queens Road Baptist Centre in Coventry City Centre; the Shelter runs over the Christmas period and provides food, warm clothing and somewhere to stay over Christmas.

Have also raised £40.00 for St Elizabeths Church in our **Live Simply Re-Cycling Scheme** which was started last September.

We also raised £43.00 for **Fair Trade event** this year.

We held a **Creation Day/Harvest Mass** last week which was a beautiful event and donated food items and fruit to our local **Peace House** and **Coventry Foodbank** at the Queens Road, Baptist Church, Coventry.

We also helped with our Easter appeal food collection some of the food was given to the **Peace House** and other items went to a **Foodbank** in Coventry.

We continue to provide funds towards **Coventry Peace House** helping refugees and asylum seekers in the city.

We also continue to provide funds towards our **Orphanage in Uganda**. Members of the parish still support the education of some of the children at the orphanage.

We continue to support providing weekly meals for the homeless and lonely at the **St Barnabas Centre**.

We support **Macmillan Nurses Biggest Coffee morning** and we have **Quiz Nights** to raise funds for various local charities.

We continue to support our Youth Group and have set up a **Youth Justice and Peace Group**.

This year we have started our journey towards being a **LiveSimply Parish** too.
